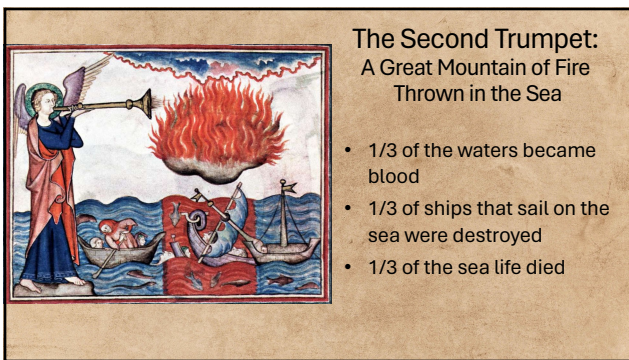

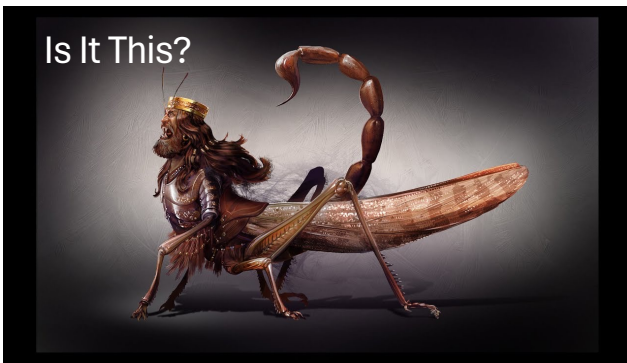

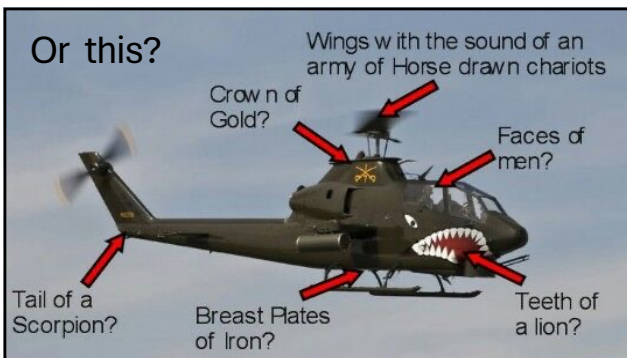
**The Fifth Trumpet:


